

The bottle was designed by Salvador Dali and crafted in Baccarat crystal, the original advert of which hangs proudly in this very bar. Inspired by fresh beginnings, we use milk clarification to create a smooth, silky after-dinner sipper, marrying jasmine, strawberry, pineapple and black rice in seamless balance.
