## SETON GORDON INSPIRED DEPOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

Discover nature and capture its beauty just like the famous Scottish naturalist, photographer, and folklorist Seton Gordon. Join Louis Graves, one of our Ghillies and photographer for an immersive photography workshop at the scenic Squirrel Hide by Queen's Drive, a short 10-minute walk from the hotel. Learn how to use a long lens to capture stunning shots of local wildlife, from playful squirrels to beautiful birds.
